- Clean Boats Clean Waters ... The first line of defense for preventing Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) from entering our lakes. Volunteers and summer interns invest more than 1,800 hours at major boat launches checking to ensure that visitor boats and trailers are clean before being launched into our waters.
- Adopt-A-Shoreline ... Shoreline monitoring to discover any new infestations of Invasive Species. Early detection of AIS leads to a significantly higher likelihood of successful treatment. 112 volunteers invest close to 1,100 hours monitoring our 109 miles of shoreline.
- Lake Management Planning ... Is the foundation for all TLWA initiatives. Studies of each lake's aquatic ecosystems have been made by a professional limnologist, lake planning and management organization to determine overall health and whether any unique problems need to be addressed. Long-term Lake Management Plans have been developed from these data.
